

The Governing Body is made up of 12 people which include the head teacher, 1 x staff, 2 x parents, 1 x local authority and 7 co-opted (made up from staff, parents & ,non-parents)

All Governors are volunteers who do not receive payment and give up their time for free.

All Governors are elected for a four year term and undertake different types of training to make sure they can do their job effectively.

We are responsible for holding the Head Teacher to account for the school's educational performance.

The Full Governing Body meets once per month. The Chair of Governors and the Head Teacher meet regularly to discuss progress.

10 Facts you might like to know about the Governing Body

There are several link governors who specialise in things like Safeguarding, Pupil Premium, Health and Safety and ICT.

We work with the Head Teacher and Senior Management Team of the school to agree on Strategies and review policies.

We regularly do class room visits to confirm that improvements are being made as set out in the 'School Improvement Plan'.

We ensure financial resources are well spent and constantly review how we can best serve the needs of the pupils.
